Directions: This is a general application used by all Grady students. The deadline to submit scholarship applications is **Friday, March 8th, 2019 at 5 p.m.**

ALL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO ROOM 312, JOURNALISM, NO LATER THAN 5 P.M. ON FRIDAY, March 8, 2019. If the office door is closed, please slide the application under the door.

Note: If you are currently studying abroad, on the Semester in Washington Program, or participating in another program outside of Athens, please contact Beth Rector at brector@uga.edu for instructions on how to submit your application.

Please note the following eligibility requirements:

1. All current Grady College undergraduates and graduate students, as well as Intended-Grady students, are eligible to apply for Grady scholarships.
2. Full-time enrollment (at least 12 hours) in Fall 2019 is required. If you will be enrolled part-time this fall you will only be considered if you are participating in an internship for academic credit, a study abroad program, or the National Student Exchange, or you are enrolled in sufficient hours to graduate in your final semester. Students who will not be enrolled at UGA in Fall 2019 are not eligible to receive Grady scholarships.
3. Students graduating in Spring or Summer 2019 are NOT eligible to apply. Students graduating in Fall 2019 or later are eligible to apply.
4. Scholarships are not automatically renewed. A new application must be submitted for consideration each academic year.
5. All applications must be TYPED. Handwritten applications will not be considered. *Please do not staple your application;* use a paper clip.

Please complete all applicable fields. This application guarantees consideration for any scholarship for which an applicant qualifies, so it is not necessary to apply for specific scholarships by name.

Grady's scholarship program is coordinated with the UGA Office of Student Financial Aid. Acceptance of a scholarship from the Grady College could result in a reduction of funds awarded from other sources. Check with the Office of Student Financial Aid (706-542-6147) if you have questions or concerns. (Note: Grady scholarships do *not* affect a student's HOPE Scholarship amount.)

Grady College scholarships are administered by the Scholarships and Awards Committee through the Director of Undergraduate Services.
