TABLE READ ASSIGNMENT: Graduating students will each have 15 pages of their work table read as per the schedule below. Pages will be projected on the large screen as they are read. Mentors will introduce their student reads. Students must recruit actors from among faculty and other students. Rehearsal arrangements are up to the students. Each Table Read, including note/comments/questions from the audience, will run no longer than 45 minutes. STUDENTS: email a PDF of your pages to Anne Hurne (anne.hurne@uga.edu) by July 25 so they can be projected and let her know if you'd like hard-copy pages for your actors. Make sure to let her know how many copies you'll need.

SCENE/SEQUENCE READ ASSIGNMENT: From their current work, Second Year Students will select one dialogue-heavy scene or sequence (no longer than 7 pages) that they are having trouble with. They will introduce the scene/sequence, giving it context, and then read it to the assembled faculty and students. We will project the scene/sequence pages on the screen as students read the scene/sequence. Students may use actors if they like, but it is not required. We will then discuss the scene/sequence with students and try to help them improve their work. This should take no longer than half an hour per student.

STUDENTS: email your scene in PDF form to Anne Hurne (anne.hurne@uga.edu) by July 25 so she can arrange for it to be projected.
