# 2024 Grant Guidelines

**The absolute deadline to submit applications is: March 15, 2024 at 5 p.m.  
NO PROPOSALS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE AND TIME.**

1. Applications will only be accepted from UGA student, faculty members or student organizations registered with the UGA Center for Student Activities and Involvement.
2. All grant applicants should thoroughly complete application forms provided by the Giving Voice to the Voiceless section committee and should be prepared to provide additional information on their project to the selection committee deems necessary.
3. Completed applications must be saved as a PDF titled LastName\_ProjectName\_GVV\_2024 and emailed as an attachment to Taejah Harper at [tjharper@uga.edu](mailto:tjharper@uga.edu) with GVV 2024 Application as the subject. All information must be typed within provided spaces on the application.
4. Grant applications will be reviewed by the selection committee in March 2024. Recipients will be notified of the committee's decision in April 2024.
5. All applicants must supply budget information for their organization/program in order to receive their grant award. Any application submitted without this information will not be considered for funding.
  - a. Typical grants under the Giving Voice to the Voiceless program range from \$500 to \$1,500, however, the selection committee welcomes requests of any size.
6. An article about grant recipients will be displayed on the Giving Voice to the Voiceless and Grady College website.
